26 January 2017, **LA review of SEN provision**. Lead reviewer: Kim Bolton (NLE)

Key finding: *“Hove Park School provides a super inclusive culture. Every learner is valued. All students in uniform and almost no litter... Review evidence supports school improvement plans are effective and Hove Park is an improving school.”*

21 – 23 March 2016, **Challenge Partners**. Lead reviewer: Tony Byrne

Key finding: *“The Quality Assurance Review found indicators that Hove Park School appears to be firmly within the Good grade as judged in the school’s Ofsted report March 2013.”*

20 June 2016, **National College of Teaching and Leadership (NCTL)**. Lead reviewer: Peter Matthews OBE (and former HMI)

Key finding: Hove Park School was awarded teaching school designation. NCTL state that *“teaching schools are all excellent schools.”*

4 October 2016, **unannounced behaviour inspection, Ofsted**. Lead HMI: Dr Simon Hughes

Key finding: *“Leaders and managers have taken effective action to maintain the high standards of behaviour and attitudes identified at the school’s previous inspection.”*

The inspection found *“detailed evidence of the full range of actions... taken to address [attendance]... the attendance of the vast majority of pupils compares well with attendance rates of pupils in other schools nationally.”*

10 January 2017, **Challenge Partner peer review, higher attaining pupil premium students**. Lead reviewer: Carole Sullivan
